
Plant Mechanic Apprenticeships

Plant mechanics service and repair the mechanical and electrical systems of mobile plant machinery including the engine, transmission, electrical, final drive, steering, hydraulic and braking systems. Plant machinery include excavators, dozers, cranes, dump trucks, generators and more.

What are some of the duties involved in a plant mechanic apprenticeship?

- Follow safe working practices in an automotive workplace
- Test, charge and replace batteries and jump-start vehicles
- Test and repair basic electrical circuits
- Diagnose and repair charging systems





- A fulltime plant mechanic apprenticeship goes for 4 years
- A plant mechanic school based apprenticeship (SBA) goes for 5 years, with the 1st year spread across Year 11 & 12
- A plant mechanic SBA must complete a minimum of 130 days of paid employment across Year 11 & 12
- Once a SBA finishes their HSC and SBA requirements they will become a 2nd year apprentice and can commence full time work

What does a typical week look like?

- ✓ 5 days per week at work
- ✓ 1 week per month at TAFE
- ✓ Employers may ask you to work Saturdays & overtime

What are some of the units offered in the course?

- Respond to customer needs and enquiries in an automotive workplace
- Read, interpret and apply engineering drawings
- Synchronise plant and equipment
- Diagnose and repair mobile plant suspension systems Inspect and service engines

- Diagnose and repair exhaust systems
- Inspect and service diesel fuel injection systems
- Overhaul diesel fuel injection system components
- Carry out manual metal arc welding on components

What qualification is completed in the apprenticeship?

Certificate III in Mobile Plant Technology

Certificate IV in Automotive Mechanical Overhauling Certificate IV in Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis
